

Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) Reporting - Student Portion

The Certification and Agreement directs each institution applying for HEERF funds to comply with Section 18004(e) of the CARES Act and submit an initial report (the “30-day Fund Report”) to the Secretary thirty (30) days from the date of the institution’s Certification and Agreement to the Department.

Each HEERF participating institution must post the information listed below on the institution’s primary website and update it every 45 days:

1. **SCTC acknowledges** that the institution has signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and assures that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. The total amount of funds that the institution will receive from the Department pursuant to the institution’s Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students is **\$69,679.00**. SCTC will use an additional \$7,821.00 from the institutional portion of the funds to make student awards.
3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of **6/15/2020 was \$44,500.00**. As of **7/20/2020, a total of \$77,500** will be awarded in student aid grants.
4. The estimated total number of students at the institution eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act is **35 students**.
5. The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of **6/15/2020 is 18**. As of **7/20/2020, a total of 29 students** will have received an emergency aid grant.
6. The method(s) used by the institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act can be found in the **Selection Criteria attachment included with this notice**.
