

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT**  
**Allegany College of Maryland**  
**And**  
**Somerset County Technology Center**

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**PROGRAM:** It is the intent of this agreement to update the existing articulation agreement between Allegany College of Maryland (ACM) and the Somerset County Technology Center (SCTC) in the program area of **Automotive Technology**.

**ELIGIBLE COLLEGE CREDIT:** Students will be eligible to receive up to twelve (12) articulated college credits for the courses listed below under the specified conditions. The articulated credits may be applied toward graduation requirements for the *Associate of Applied Science degree in Automotive Technology* or the one-year *Certificate in Automotive Technology*. Students may enroll in either program without duplication of credit.

**REQUIREMENTS:**

- This program is NATEF certified and must maintain this certification to maintain this agreement.
- The student must have a cumulative average of “B” or better in all SCTC automotive courses, and an overall “C” or better in all high school courses.
- Minimum of a grade of “B” or better in the automotive courses that correlate to the ACM course.
- The student must pass, at the Advanced Level, the NOCTI Assessment in all areas to be considered for this articulation.
- Students wishing to obtain credit for Automotive 103, 114, and/or 215 must pass a practical test(s) with a score(s) of 80% or better, as administered by one or both of the Automotive faculty at ACM. Students wishing to obtain credit for Automotive 105 must have their SCTC Automotive teacher complete a competency checklist (provided by ACM) verifying the student's skills in all required areas.

- Students can apply for articulated credit by using the online web-based application form located at: [https://alleganycollege.formstack.com/forms/articulated\\_credit](https://alleganycollege.formstack.com/forms/articulated_credit).
- Students must apply and enroll in the *Associate of Applied Science degree in Automotive Technology* or the *one-year Certificate in Automotive Technology* program. Student have up to two years to apply for and receive this articulated credit.
- Articulated credit will be posted to the official college transcript once all of the required documentation has been received and recorded by the college.

**BENEFITS:** Credits will be posted as “credit by articulation”. Students will receive credit, but no grade, for the articulated course. There will be no effect on the student’s college GPA. There will be no tuition or other costs associated with obtaining articulated credit. Articulated credit is not eligible for transfer to other institutions.

**CONCLUSION:** This agreement can be amended or discontinued at any time by either party, with adequate notice to avoid hindering the educational plans of the students.
