

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
Allegany College of Maryland
And
Somerset County Technology Center

PROGRAM: It is the intent of this agreement to update the existing articulation agreement between Allegany College of Maryland (ACM) **Computer Technology** program and the Somerset County Technology Center (SCTC) **Computer Networking** program.

ELIGIBLE COLLEGE CREDIT: Students will be eligible to receive twelve, fifteen or sixteen* (12 or 15-16*) college credits for Computer Technology courses which may be applied toward graduation requirements under the specified conditions for the *Associate of Applied Science degree in Computer Technology – Area of Concentration in Cybersecurity*, *Associate of Applied Science degree in Computer Technology – Area of Concentration Technical Support* or the *Cybersecurity certificate*. Students may enroll in either program or certificate without duplication of coursework.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Students must complete the entire IT networking program of study for Cisco at the SCTC, and must have a “B” grade or better in all courses under that program to receive full articulated credit.
- Students can apply for articulated credit by using the online web-based application form located at: https://alleganycollege.formstack.com/forms/articulated_credit.
- Students must apply and enroll in the *Associate of Applied Science degree in Computer Technology – Area of Concentration in Cybersecurity*, *Associate of Applied Science degree in Computer Technology – Area of Concentration Technical Support* or the *Cybersecurity certificate* program. Students have up to two years to apply for and receive this articulated credit.
- Articulated credit will be posted to the official college transcript once all of the required documentation has been received and recorded by the college.

- COMP-101 (Computer Literacy) is a required course in the Cybersecurity certificate and degree programs. Students can either take the course at ACM or complete via a Credit by Exam (CBE). Students must complete and pass the COMP-101 course or Credit by Exam in order to receive college credit for that course.

BENEFITS: Credits will be posted as “credit by articulation”. Students will receive credit, but no grade, for the articulated course. There will be no effect on the student’s college GPA. There will be no tuition or other costs associated with obtaining articulated credit. Articulated credit is not eligible for transfer to other institutions.

CONCLUSION: This agreement can be amended or discontinued at any time by either party, with adequate notice to avoid hindering the educational plans of students.
