

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
Allegany College of Maryland
And
Somerset County Technology Center

PROGRAM: It is the intent of this agreement to update the existing articulation agreement between Allegany College of Maryland (ACM) and the Bedford County Technology Center (SCTC) in the program areas of **Culinary Arts and Hospitality Management**.

ELIGIBLE COLLEGE CREDIT: Students will be eligible to receive up to twelve (10) articulated college credits for the courses listed below under specified conditions. The articulated credits may be applied toward graduation requirements for the *Associate of Applied Science degree in Culinary Arts*, the *Associate of Applied Science degree in Hospitality Management*, and the one-year *Certificate in Baking Essentials*, *Cooking Essentials*, *Brewing Operations* or *Restaurant Management*. Students may enroll in either program or certificate without duplication of coursework.

Associate of Applied Science Degree in Culinary Arts (10 credits).

Associate of Applied Science Degree in Hospitality Management (4 credits):

REQUIREMENTS:

- The SCTC Culinary Arts program of study must include a course in the area of food sanitation, which must be taught by a registered ServSafe instructor certified by the National Restaurant Association (NRA). Students must obtain a passing rate of at least 75% (60 out 80) on the NRA ServSafe certification exam.

- Students must have a cumulative average of “C” or better in the SCTC Culinary Arts program of study.
- Students can apply for articulated credit by using the online web-based application form located at: https://alleganycollege.formstack.com/forms/articulated_credit.
- Students must apply and enroll in the *Associate of Applied Science degree in Culinary Arts*, the *Associate of Applied Science degree in Hospitality Management*, and the one-year *Certificate in Baking Essentials, Cooking Essentials, Brewing Operations or Restaurant Management* program. Students have up to two years to apply for and receive this articulated credit.
- Articulated credit will be posted to the official college transcript once all of the required documentation has been received and recorded by the college.

BENEFITS: Credits will be posted as “credit by articulation”. Students will receive credit, but no grade, for the articulated course. There will be no effect on the student’s college GPA. There will be no tuition or other costs associated with obtaining articulated credit. Articulated credit is not eligible for transfer to other institutions.

CONCLUSION: This agreement can be amended or discontinued at any time by either party, with adequate notice to avoid hindering the educational plans of the students.
