



Somerset County Technology Center Practical Nursing Pre-Entrance Exam Information For the 2025 – 2026 Cohort

All prospective SCTC nursing students must take the pre-entrance exam and successfully pass with a score of **40.7 or higher**. **Only 5-6 seats are available per test date**. An interview with the Director of Practical Nursing will follow immediately after successful completion of the TEAS examination. Admission information and requirements will be reviewed with the applicant during the interview.

Create an account with ATI Testing and register online for the TEAS examination to be completed at the Somerset County Technology Center per designated date/time scheduled. Cost of the TEAS examination is approximately \$87.

The TEAS examination is composed of 170 items, 20 of which are unscored pretest questions. The format of the questions is as follows:

- Multiple select (select all that apply)
- Supply answer (fill-in-the-blank numeric)
- Ordering (placing options in sequential order)
- Hot spot (select an area of an image)

Questions from the four subject areas are grouped into separate sections, each has an individual timed limit.
